## **“Zeitz MOCAA – the Making of”**

This original redesign of the interior created new functional spaces for galleries, foyer and pause spaces, exposed staircases, transparent lifts and an administration area. This was supplemented with a new sculptural atrium carved out from the heart of the silos' existing cylindrical concrete structures. Newly fitted skylights flood the interior spaces with natural light in a magical way whilst the old basement and roof top areas are activated with new uses.

We will be hearing from Mark Noble, Development Director, V&A Waterfront, and Tessa Brunette from Arup.

Tessa will predominantly talk about how Arup's façade team delivered a series of varied and complex designs, the most visible of which are the iconic glazed 'pillows' that required close collaboration with the architect in order to realise the technically challenging design intent in a pragmatic and buildable manner.

Other key stakeholders will also be joining us.
